Our success going forward will continue to be driven by the extraordinary innovation that propelled the United States and the ROK's growth, and both nations must continue to be engines driving the cutting-edge technology of the next century. While doing so, our countries must lead the way together to create a global architecture for tech and data security that will protect our ability to engage in commerce while protecting consumer privacy and strengthening national security for both nations. There is so much more potential we can tap to bring this critical partnership to even higher levels.

We again welcome and commend your work to further strengthen the historic relationship between the United States and the ROK. We look forward to working with you on all aspects of this relationship to ensure that the next 70 years are as fruitful and impactful as the previous 7 decades we celebrate this year.
