Application Deadline: April 9, 2024

Description: UAIP projects will support the development of urban agriculture and innovative production. Funding will support farmers, gardeners, citizens, government officials, schools, members of tribal communities, and other stakeholders in areas where access to fresh foods is limited or unavailable. Projects may target areas of food access, education, business and start-up costs for new farmers, and development of policies related to zoning and other needs of urban production.

Port Infrastructure Development Program (PIDP): [Recurring] U.S. Department of
Transportation (DOT) Maritime Administration

Application Deadline: April 30, 2024

Description: PIDP grants provide funding for projects that improve the overall safety or reliability of the movement of goods into, out of, around, or within ports. Eligible uses include projects that improve the safety, efficiency, or reliability of loading and unloading of goods at the port; moving of goods into, out of, around, or within a port; operating improvements; and environmental and emissions mitigation measures.
