

OV FY24 Meeting the Basic Needs of Underserved Crime Victims: Department of Justice (DOJ): Office for Victims of Crime

Application Deadline: Accepting Applications through July 29, 2024.

Description: The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Office for Victims of Crime (OVC) is seeking applications from organizations that provide culturally responsive services to crime victims and survivors from communities that have been historically underserved, marginalized, adversely affected by inequality, and disproportionately impacted by crime, violence, and victimization.

WaterSMART Grants: Water and Energy Efficiency Grants for Fiscal Year 2024: Department of the Interior (DOI): Bureau of Reclamation

Application Deadline: Accepting Applications through November 13, 2024

Description: This Water and Energy Efficiency Grants Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) provides funding for projects that result in quantifiable water savings, implement renewable energy components, and support broader sustainability benefits. These projects conserve and use water more efficiently; increase the production of renewable energy; mitigate conflict risk in areas at a high risk of future water conflict; and accomplish other benefits that contribute to sustainability in the Western United States.

Expanding Access to Women's Health Grant: Department of Health and Human Services (HHS): Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services

Application Deadline: Accepting Applications through August 7, 2024.

Description: Section 2794(c) of the Public Health Service Act (PHS Act) appropriates \$250 million to the Secretary to award grants to States to assist them with the health insurance rate review process from fiscal years (FYs) 2010 through 2014. Section 2794(c)(2)(B) specifies that any rate review grant funds not obligated by the end of FY 2014 will remain available to the

Secretary for grants to States for planning and implementing the health insurance market reforms and consumer protections under Part A of Title XXVII of the PHS Act. Applicants may use grant funds for a variety of objectives related to planning and implementation of the following pre-selected provisions of Part A of Title XXVII of the PHS Act to expand coverage of, and access to, reproductive and maternal health services

- Section 2707 Comprehensive Health Insurance Coverage (Essential Health Benefits Package)
- II. Section 2713 Coverage of Preventive Health Services

Rural Energy for America Program Renewable Energy Systems & Energy Efficiency

Application Deadline: Accepting Applications through September 30, 2024

Description: The Rural Business-Cooperative Service (the Agency) is issuing a second Notice of Solicitation of Applications (Notice) under the Rural Energy for America Program (REAP) as referenced in the notice that was published in the Federal Register on December 16, 2022. This second notice announces the availability of \$1.055 billion in Inflation Reduction Act funds across six quarterly cycles to be obligated by September 30, 2024. This Notice also announces the types of projects that qualify for a federal grant share not to exceed 50 percent of the project cost, a set-aside for underutilized renewable energy technologies (underutilized technologies), as well as scoring revisions to support Administration priorities. Applications received on or after April 1, 2023, will be evaluated and scored according to the provisions listed in this Notice, unless otherwise amended via a subsequent notice. The Notice will not be applied retroactively to any applications previously filed. However, a portion of the funding made available under this notice may be made available to add to pooled funds to fund any Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 applications submitted prior to March 31, 2023, with no other changes in funding provisions or scoring allowed.
