ACTIVE DUTY.—In the case of an employee who 1 2 is a spouse of a member of the Armed Forces 3 who is participating in covered active duty, in 4 lieu of the definition in subparagraph (A), the term 'eligible employee' means an employee who 5 has been employed for at least 90 calendar days 6 by the employer with respect to whom leave is 7 requested.". 8
